Maths	<p>Directed numbers This week we will be :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identifying positive and negative numbers Recording positive and negative numbers with +or - sign raised. <p>A positive number is greater than zero A negative number is less than zero.</p> <p>Numbers that are greater than 0 are written with a positive (plus) sign. +6 is called positive 6 (or plus6) Numbers less than 0 are written with a negative (or minus) sign. -3 is called negative 3 (minus 3).
